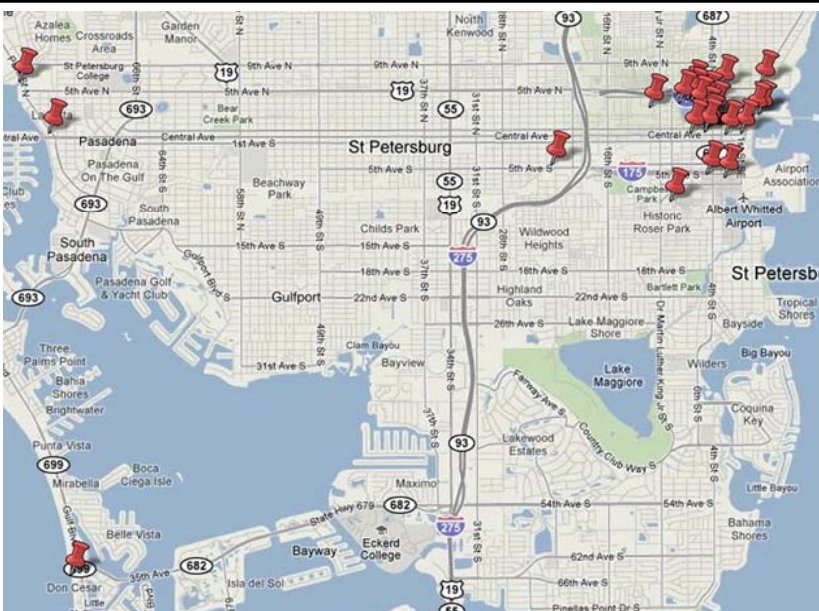

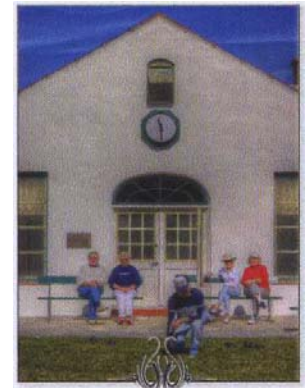

We welcome you to the first area High Dynamic Range (HDR) photography exhibit, showcasing cutting edge photographic recreations of thirty-two historical images from the History Museum archives.

This exhibit incorporates other cutting edge technology too. In a real sense, a portion of Pinellas County visual history is being served here through four mediums of current technology. In addition to HDR photography, the museum in-house video screens are rotating the images throughout the event and the St. Pete Tweeters are capturing all the action via cell phones and sending it to Twitter in real time for global distribution over the Internet. The Museum of History is proud to present both the past and the present for your viewing pleasure.

## HDR Photography

“High Dynamic Range Imaging is a method to digitally capture, store, and edit the full luminosity range of an image.” Christian Bloch, author, *The HDR Handbook*.

Others describe it as the ability of a camera, due to multiple exposures of the same image, to offer a broader range of luminosity between the darkest and lightest areas of a scene or subject. This range can capture brightest sunlight to faintest starlight thus offering the viewer intensity levels found in real scenes and exposing details in an image not available to standard digital imaging nor traditional photography. HDR photographers prefer to shoot in Raw and use software programs to manipulate their images for tonal quality and excellence.
